Coolidge Community Roll-Off Fall Clean-Up Dates & Rules

November 17th – 24th, 2023

Types of Waste:

City containers are for disposal of residential, construction and commercial waste **ONLY**. No medical waste or hazardous waste is permitted in City-owned containers. Special arrangements with the landfill and the hauler are required **PRIOR** to the disposal of any hazardous waste. State and federal regulations define hazardous waste. Tires, batteries, oils or petroleum-based products are **NOT** allowed for disposal in City-owned containers. Fees will be incurred.

Prohibited Waste:

Georgia regulations identify several items of waste that are specifically prohibited from disposal in landfills. In addition, the following section of the rule identifies the landfill operator as in violation of the rule if he/she accepts the prohibited waste for disposal.

Rule 391-3-4-04(6) states:

(b) The following solid waste are specifically prohibited from disposal at solid waste disposal facilities in Georgia:

1. Lead Acid Batteries
2. Liquid waste in landfills, except as allowed in (9) below
3. Regulated quantities of hazardous waste as defined in rules promulgated by The Board of Natural Resources, Chapter 391-3-11.
4. Radioactive waste as defined in rules promulgated by the Board of Natural Resources, Chapter 391-3-9, Radioactive Waste Material Disposal; and
5. Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCB) waste as defined in 40 CFR, Part 761.

(c) Any generator who disposes of prohibited waste or person who accepts for disposal a prohibited waste shall be deemed to be in violation of these rules.
