Call to Order

Discuss/Review:

PLAYGROUND:

Council discussed the decision of whether to move the Playground to the Methodist Church property or keep it at the current location. Public opinion seems to be split down the middle. When asked for the opinion of residents who live in the immediate vicinity of the proposed new location next to the church, there was some discrepancy in their responses on whether they would like the Playground to be placed there or not.

There was a heated exchange between Councilmembers F. Johnson and M. Johnson, who were in opposition regarding how to come to a final decision. Councilmember M. Johnson suggested putting the subject on the election ballot for the November 7th Election and let the people vote and make the decision for Council. She said we could store the Playground equipment at the City Shop when it is delivered and have someone come back and install it once the people decide where they want the Park. Councilmember F. Johnson disagreed with, now, postponing the project until the Election in November when, recently, Councilmember M. Johnson had an issue with this project being "put off for five years" in her argument for a decision to be made, and he disagreed with having to pay someone to come back and install it at extra cost to the City when the company delivering the product will install it upon delivery on site at no extra cost. He stated we have a fast-approaching deadline of when the equipment will be delivered and that Council had agreed to stop prolonging the decision and put it to a vote at the next Council meeting with a quorum in order to be done with it and move forward.
